

# Cleaning and care of laminate flooring

## Learn how to take care of your laminate flooring properly

Krono Original high-quality laminate flooring has a lifespan of several decades.

Basically the following applies: Laminate floorings are extremely robust and low-maintenance; nevertheless correct floor cleaning is important. Small marks can be quickly and easily removed with a damp cloth.

To ensure that your laminate flooring looks as good as new, please apply the following care instructions:

- In particularly soiled areas, such as in the entrance area, dust control mats protect against wear.
- Furniture feet should be provided with felt glides to prevent scratches: Please note that failure to do so could invalidate your warranty. Please check the felt glides regularly and replace them if necessary. Even felt glides are subject to wear.
- Office chairs with castors should be equipped with soft chair castors made of rubber.
- Avoid stagnant moisture in any case. Take special care with flowerpots, vases, and wherever there are taps.
- Please ensure during cleaning that the cloth is never wet, but only damp.
- If you clean your laminate flooring with cleaning agents, you must make sure that no residues remain on the floor.

The right care product for your Krono Original® laminate

Please never use care products containing wax or oils. These cannot penetrate into the laminate flooring, so they form a film on the surface that attracts dirt like a magnet.



For regular cleaning, we recommend Krono Original laminate cleaner. If you use cleaning solutions or cleaning agents, you should always dry the floor so that no residues of the cleaning agent remain on the floor.
